**ANIMAL RECOVERY MISSION RETURNS FROM WOOLSEY FIRES AFTER
WEEKLONG SEARCH AND RESCUE OPERATIONS**

Miami, FL - November 20, 2018 - Animal Recovery Mission (ARM), a vanguard animal welfare organization, recently launched their Disaster Response Team (DRT). ARM DRT members are returning from California after assisting in the search and rescue of multiple animals impacted by the raging Woolsey fires. The fires are the deadliest wildfires in the state's history with 50 plus confirmed human deaths. The number of farmed animals, wildlife, and pets that have suffered and ultimately perished far exceed that number. Charred remains of innocent animals which attempted to escape the imminent flames are seen all too frequently. ARM DRT members provided aide to several domestic and farm animals.

ARM assisted the LA County Sheriffs Office, LA County Fire Department and the Seattle Fire Department with multiple operations. ARM team members were also part of a search team tasked with locating and rescuing mountain lions.

The Animal Recovery Mission is a Non-Profit animal cruelty investigative organization based in Miami Beach, Florida.
